This packet includes the document *Instructions and Assessments for Your Parenting Plan*. Complete the assessment to determine which parenting plan may be right for your family. Purchase the appropriate Parenting Plan from the Clerk of Court, or download the plan from the 12th Judicial Circuit's website at <http://www.jud12.flcourts.org>. Before you fill in any part of the Parenting Plan, you should make a copy of the blank form. Save this copy for when you are ready to fill out a final version to file with the Court. If the court refers your case to mediation, be sure to review and complete a draft of the Parenting Plan prior to attending mediation. Once your proposed Parenting Plan is complete, provide the other party with a copy of the Parenting Plan. If you and the other party agree on a plan, file ONE plan. If you do not agree, you will each file a proposed plan for the court to consider.

** All parties to a dissolution of marriage proceeding with minor children or a paternity action are required by Florida Statute, with or without a separate court order, to complete the Parent Education and Family Stabilization Course and file proof of compliance prior to the entry by the court of a final judgment.
